DRESS CODE

The objective of the dress code is to accentuate the dancer's movements and body positions, enabling the teacher to provide precise instructions and technical corrections.

Appropriate dance attire and shoes are required for all classes. The studio has some "loaner" shoes and dance attire, however not all sizes are available. Dancers dressed inappropriately may be asked to leave class.

Not allowed:

- Jeans, jean shorts, jean skirts
- Jewelry, hair bows, barrettes
- Street clothing
- Baggy clothing or tight clothing that restricts movement

TAP, BALLET, JAZZ (pre-school combo classes)

- Any color leotard
- Any color tights
- Skirt, tutu, dance shorts – OK
- Ballet shoes
- Tap shoes

BALLET (Ballet 1 through Pointe)

- Light pink leather or canvas ballet shoes
- Pre-pointe and Pointe shoes are allowed ONLY after studio recommendation/authorization
- Light pink full footed tights
- Solid Royal Blue Balera brand leotards (www.dancewearsolutions.com)
- Black chiffon ballet skirts may be allowed at the discretion of the teacher
- Hair **must** be secured in a bun
- Male dancers will wear black ballet shoes, black dance pants, and a royal blue studio shirt

JAZZ

- Leather jazz shoes
- Paws or socks, in lieu of shoes, may be allowed at teacher's discretion
- Stretchy clothing such as leotards, unitards, tights, dance pants
- Hair must be pulled back from the face

TAP

- Tap shoes – A list of approved Capezio and Bloch styles is available at the front desk
- Stretchy clothing such as leotards, unitards, tights, dance pants
- Hair must be pulled back from the face

HIP HOP

- Tennis shoes
- Stretchy clothing such as leotards, unitards, tights, dance pants
- Hair must be pulled back from the face

Male dancers must wear appropriate shoes and may wear stretchy shorts and t-shirts.
Combo classes require stretchy clothing and shoes appropriate to each dance genre in the combo.
Pre-school Tap, Ballet, Jazz combo classes require tap and ballet shoes only.
Teachers for specialty classes such as Yoga will specify the dress code for those classes.
